# Florida Preparatory Academy Experiential / Excursion Week 2019/2020

## Florida Prep students are learning about different areas inside and outside of the classroom!! Where are we going and learning about this year?

Florida Prep is planning a school-wide experiential / excursion week during the **week of March 9, 2020**, the week before Spring Break. Excursion Week is an exciting chance for students to explore and discover amazing topics of student that they may have never had the chance to see before.

All Florida Prep students are **required** to attend one of the experiences listed below. There will **NOT** be normal school classes during that week. All trips include transportation to and from the destination, lodging, food, and entry into all locations.

Students may choose from the following experiences:

## Washington D.C. Experiences and College Visits

\$1400 – High School and 8th Grade Students Only

Students will be traveling to Washington D. C. for a 5-day / 4-night experience where they will be able to see local sights, experience college visits at three local universities and experience learning through workshops and opportunities outside of the classroom.

## Middle School STEAM Adventure

\$200 - Middle School Students Only

Students will stay local to Florida Prep and experience two full day trips with a STEAM focus. Students will be learning about the different ways in which STEAM is part of learning and experience projects and activities to help build concrete connections between the five areas.

## **Ecosystems of Florida**

\$200 - High School Students Only

Students will engage in learning about the different natural ecosystems of Florida. This will include visits to local areas and will end in an all day excursion to one of Florida's natural springs. Students will spend the majority of the week out of the classroom experiencing the nature of Florida.

### **Asian Culture Immersion**

\$200 – High School Students Only

Experience what it is like to be part of the Asian culture. Create a piece of art representing Asia and spend the day experiencing Asian cuisine and learning about cultural immersion. In addition, students will have the opportunity to create Calligraphy drawings and have an appreciation for the culture and beauty of Asia.

## Florida Prep - The Musical

#### \$100 - High School Students Only

Experience what it takes to create a small musical production here on the Florida Prep Campus. From inspiration to production, students will take part in creating a musical theater performance. Through this interactive experience, students will have the opportunity to block staging, experience an orchestra rehearsal and experience all aspects of show production.

## WWII - History Through Film

#### \$50 - High School Students Only

History through film will be a combination classroom and field trip learning opportunity engaging students in a variety of concepts surrounding World War II. Lessons will be structured around films and documentaries that the students will watch on campus. Students will be immersed in this time of history.

## Film Study and Analysis

#### \$50 - High School Students Only

An in-depth analysis of the making and creating of film; Film Study and Analysis will be a combination classroom and field trip learning opportunity engaging in all areas of cinematography. Through this interactive experience, students will participate in the analysis of different genres of film and how each effects the decisions made by the director or producers. This experience will allow students to create a deeper understanding of cinematography.

## **Experiential Internships**

#### \$50 – High School Students Only (Preference Given to Juniors and Seniors)

Experience what it is like to be a member of the working community. Students will immerse themselves into professional working environments for an experience of what life would be like. All students interested in experiential internships will need to apply for these positions and go through an interview process.

All experiences have a minimum and maximum number of participants. All spaces are based on availability and sign-ups will be conducted via Google Form beginning 10/11/2019. If your student chooses a trip that does not get the minimum amount of students, you may be asked to choose another experience.

If your student chooses a trip that has met the maximum number of students, you may be asked to choose another experience and will be placed on a wait list.
